

Terms and Conditions for Edu Visit at PT Garuda Maintenance Facility Aero Asia Tbk (GMF)

Terms:

1. Fill out the Edu Visit form on the GMF website at least 3 (three) weeks before the planned visit.
2. The maximum number of participants is 50 people, with private transportation consisting of up to 1 large bus at the participants' own expense.

Conditions:

1. Submit a photo of the participant's ID card (KTP), the bus driver's license (SIM B, if using a bus), and the list of participants no later than 5 (five) days before the visit to the email list-tsc@gmf-aeroasia.co.id for entrance permit purposes.
2. Arrive at the GMF facility no later than 15 minutes after the scheduled time.
3. Wear closed shoes and neat, modest clothing while in the GMF area.
4. Participants must follow the instructions from the organizers and GMF's safety unit (K3).
5. Pay attention to safety aspects throughout the activity.
6. Participants intending to bring a camera, laptop, or tablet must report the specifications of the camera and other photography equipment no later than 5 (five) days before the visit. Each group is only allowed to bring 1 (one) camera and/or laptop/tablet.
7. Taking photos must comply with safety procedures and personal protective equipment (PPE) requirements.
8. Photography is only allowed in designated areas. GMF reserves the right to delete photos deemed inappropriate or harmful to the company's image.
9. Participants are not allowed to wear collarless shirts, sleeveless tops, short pants or skirts, or open-heeled sandals.
10. Smoking is prohibited within the GMF area.
11. Participants are not allowed to bring sharp objects, metal-containing items, firearms, illegal drugs, or alcoholic beverages into the GMF area.
12. Participants are not allowed to distribute images for commercial purposes.
13. Do not touch aircraft equipment and instruments.
14. Activities outside the designated areas and entering the aircraft are prohibited.
